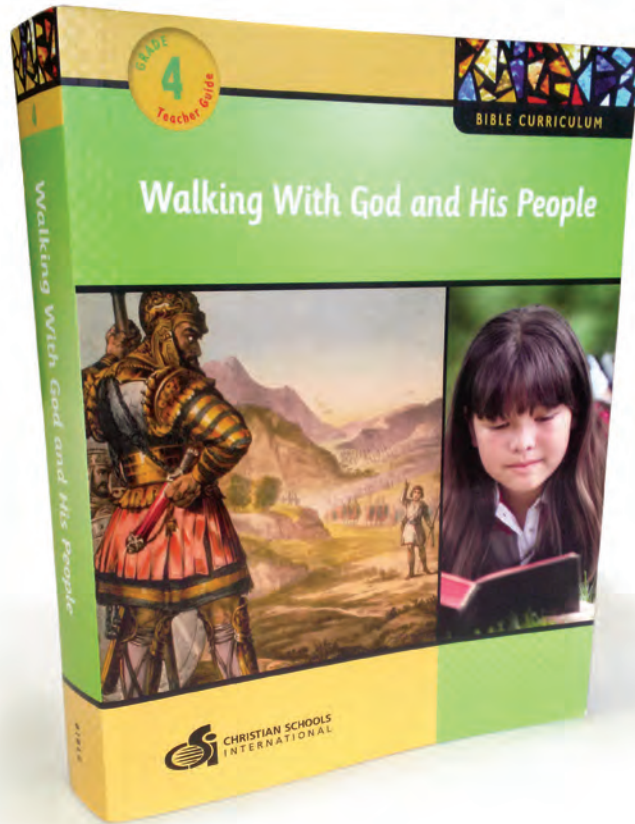

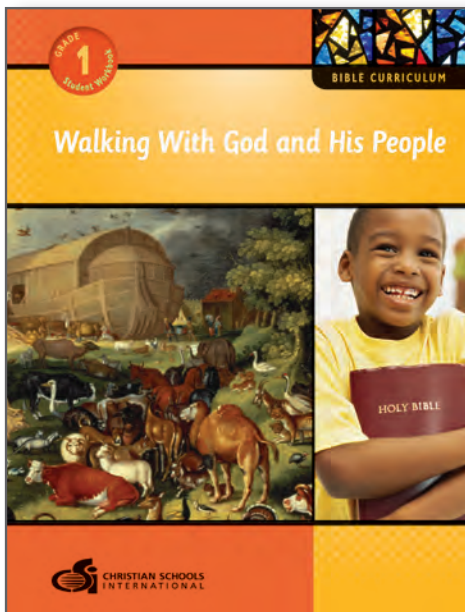
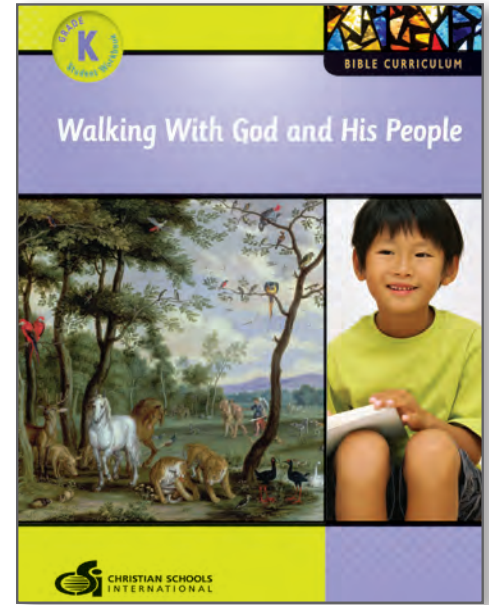


## PreK

Focusing on God's care for his people, students dig deeper into the Old and New Testaments to discover the connections between them. Workbook activities support Bible passages and memorization.

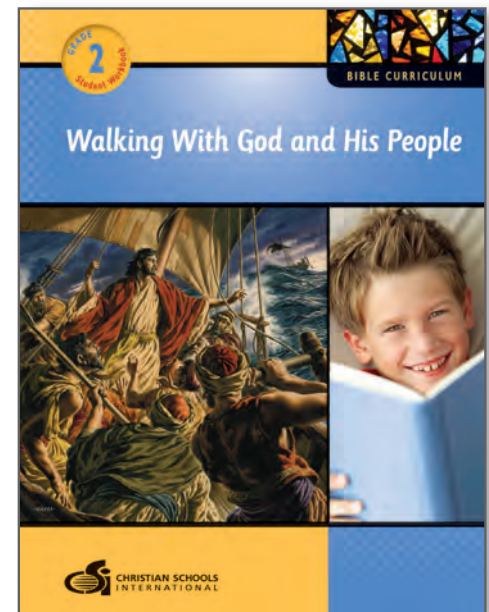


## Grade 1

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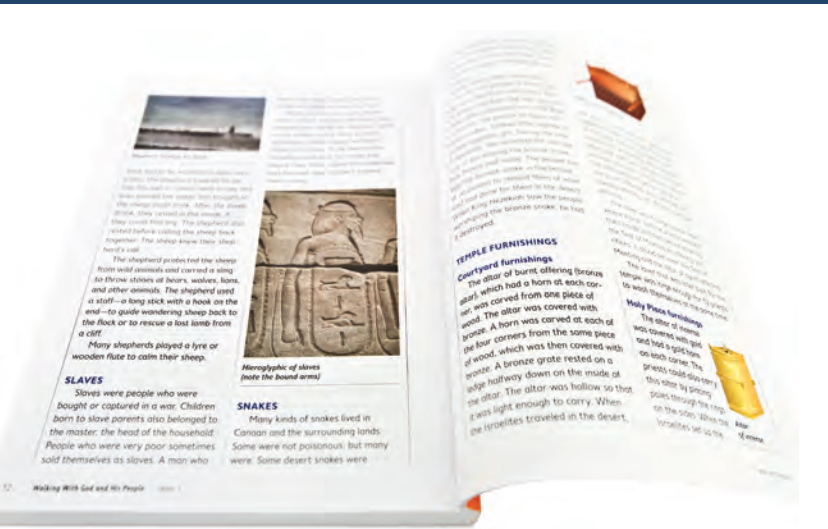
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# Walking With God and His People Grades 3-5

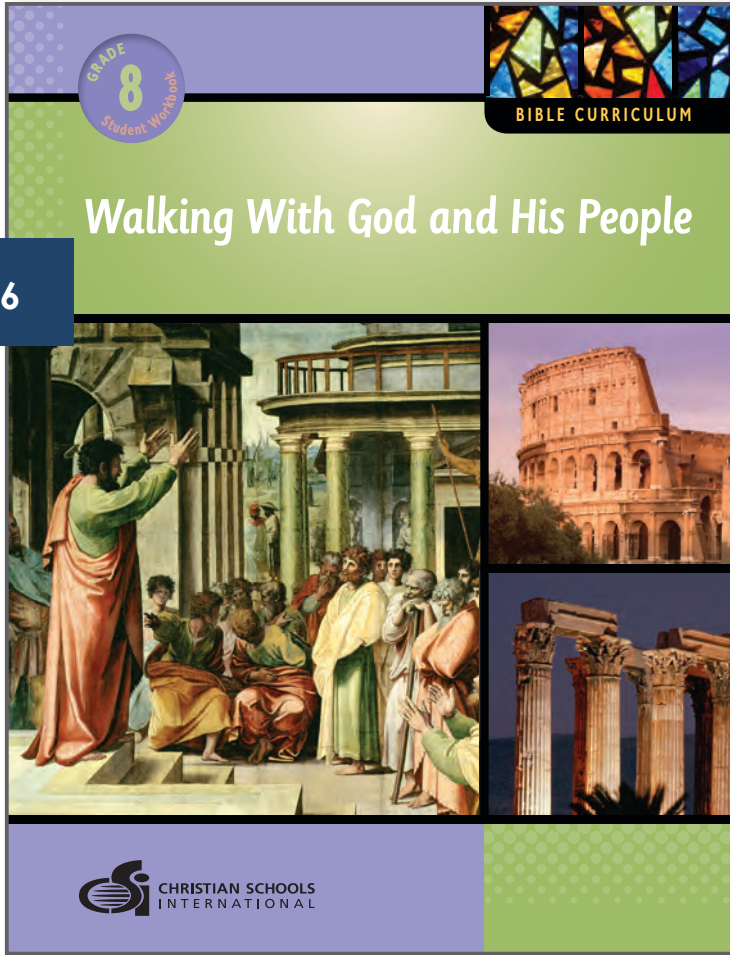

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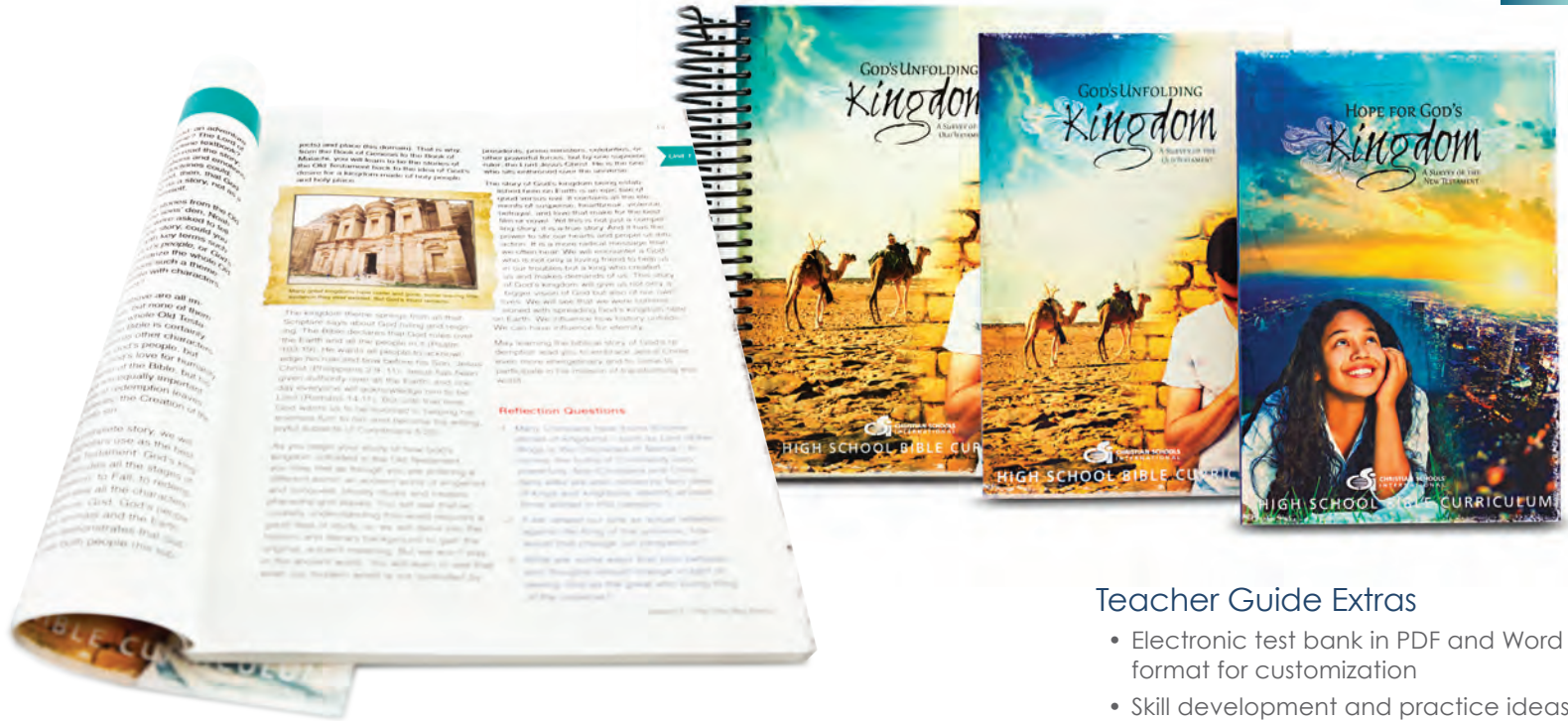

### Daniel: A Good Reputation

LESSON 1

#### Bible Reference

Daniel 2:31-45

#### To the Teacher

Christianity is a historical religion. Its basis is a story, a story with threads woven throughout the Old and New Testaments, as well as encompassing nearly 2,000 years of subsequent history. Human history is in fact synonymous with "His Story"—God's unfolding story as he continues to reveal more and more of himself and his master plan to his people. The birth of Jesus punctuated history at the exactly appropriate moment, and the climax of redemptive history, the kingdom of God, is yet to come in its fullness.

In this lesson, students will learn that God sovereignly controls history. Nothing happens by chance, and history isn't the tangled mess we might perceive it to be, looking as we do at the bottom of the tapestry, with its crisscrossing threads and bulky knots. Rather, history is moving persistently forward, right on God's schedule, toward the final outcome of the salvation of the world. God's hand is continuously active in the process. He has worked in the past, is working in the present, and will continue to work in future events as yet unknown to us.

Students will read about Nebuchadnezzar's dream, a dream that entailed a statue with a head of gold, a chest and arms of silver, a mid-section and thighs of bronze, legs of iron, and feet of iron and clay. In this ancient Babylonian monarch's dream a rock took out the statue, and a mountain rose up in its place. Daniel interpreted the various metals as corresponding with empires. The outcome: The four formidable empires eventually amounted to nothing in comparison to the kingdom of God.

Nebuchadnezzar's dream-vision of the future serves as the scaffolding for this intertestamental unit. Daniel's interpretation of the dream will be addressed in the last five lessons, but in the first five the statue will serve as a timeline compass, helping students maintain their bearings in the maze of ancient history.

It is important that the Book of Daniel not be used to predict the future. Rather, Nebuchadnezzar's dream-vision of the future kingdom of God should receive the emphasis.

#### Lesson Highlights

- \* God sovereignly controls history—past, present, and future.
- \* The kingdom of God, while in some sense already here, is still coming in terms of its ultimate fulfillment.
- \* Human plans cannot be considered to be parallel in importance to God's plan.

#### Background

The Book of Daniel can be loosely separated into two parts. Chapters 1-6 contain the "hero stories" students love to study, while Chapters 7-12, the much more difficult portion of the book, record apocalyptic visions about which Daniel wrote in the first person. An apocalypse is a dream-vision of the future (the Book of Revelation is another example). This is different from prophecy. The Book of Daniel was classified already in Old Testament times not with prophetic literature but with the "writings."
